

The Alavanyo e.V., founded in 2000, is a registered and approved charitable organisation that has already completed a number of projects in Ghana's poorest regions within only a very short time.

COMPLETED PROJECTS

Education projects

Building of a school for 120 young people (Secondary Technical School)

Purchase of a school bus

Building of a girls' hostel for 60 girls

A project for women, 25 sewing machines for making clothes, one knitting machine

Support for a nursery school with 80 pre-school children

Sponsorships for nearly 100 needy children which have sponsor-parents all over Germany

A kindergarten building for Hohoe

Agricultural projects

Farm project for growing rice, cassaba, pineapple

Installation of 7 mobile pumps in the 7 largest villages in Alavanyo for the irrigation of fields (better yield through harvesting fruits in the dry periods)

Grascutter farm project

Music projects - A support for one of the traditional music groups of Alavanyo: 2 trumpets, 1 tenor saxophon, 1 alt saxophon, 1 trombone are donated by two famous german actors, to teach the young up-coming on learning these instruments. Further instruments will follow

Health projects

A 40-foot container full of emergency goods mainly for the sick and handicapped

STILL IN PROGRESS / ALREADY STARTED PROJECTS

More Health Projects

Setting up an organisation of Ghanaian and German doctors to fight against Buruli Ulcus, Guinea Worm, elephantiasis and other deseases we stumbled on in Ghana during our last visit. We are getting support for these activities from the German BNI Institute, which is already working in Kumasi, Ghana, and of the German Rotary Voulunteer Doctors, an organisation, which has 100 doctors working and teaching in third world countries, 60 of them only in Ghana.

Setting up of a doctor's surgery to recognize and prevent illnesses in good time. Medical help is often sought too late due to the poverty of the people.

Aids and polio provision

Eyeoperations for needy patients

Appendectomys for needy patients

Sponsorships for further needy children (some of them orphans)

Sitsofe's third operation in Germany

Operations for other children urgently needing help

Grants for the education of highly talented children who need support.

Water supply project for the whole region through installation of a draw works and pipelines. The majority of the population, even many children, suffer from Bilharziasis, a disease contracted through contaminated water which in serious cases can even be lethal. The first donation money of 15.000 Euro for this project is already collected.

FINISHED/NEARLY FINISHED PROJECTS

Orphant home at SOVIE

An orphant home with class/ and bedrooms is finished and will be opened soon.

Clinical Project EASTERN REGION

A clinical project in Maase, Eastern Region, is nearly completed. Opening will be at least in November.

GERMAN GOVERNMENT FINISHED PROJECT

The sewing project for women is realised to make the women able to earn their own money. The Project has been sponsored by the German Government. His excellency, the German ambassador Hon. Peter Linder has made the opening ceremony at the end of october 2004.

PROJECT FOR THE WHOLE OF GHANA
Alamsamo School feeding project for Ghana
INTO SCHOOL, OUT OF HUNGER

This project has been started in July 2008, at the Senior Technical High School at Alavanyo Kpeme, Voltaregion, Ghana, a school, which has been built by the mother of Sara Fayed, Mamaga Nyonufiaga Akosua I., the paramount queenmother of SASADU Traditional areas, in 2000. 310 girls and boys are attending this school at the moment. All children will get the financial support for one warm meal a day. The sponsor agreed to support this project for at least ten years with the necessary support for 310 children. It will be more than GHC 150,000.-- It is a peace project with Nkonya, where a school with 100 children is supported, too. Further projects all over Ghana will follow.
